# Theme

What is a theme?

- The First World War
- The First World War lasted from 1914 to 1918.
- The First World War is a watershed in the history of wars.



What is a theme?

- Diana Li Scholarship
- The Diana Li Scholarship is worth four years' tuition fees.
- The Diana Li Scholarship has helped many students from poor families to finish their university education.

# Structure

- Introduction – introduce theme and sub-themes
- Body – each theme in one paragraph, supported by sub-themes
- Summary – repeat / refine theme; do not start something new / err on the light side



# 'What I have Lived for'

Theme: My life is governed by three passions

- Sub-theme 1: (1<sup>st</sup> passion) longing for love
- Sub-theme 2: (2<sup>nd</sup> passion) search for knowledge
- Sub-theme 3: (3<sup>rd</sup> passion) pity for mankind



# Body: sub-theme 1

Why seek love?

- s-s-t 1: brings ecstasy
- s-s-t 2: relieves loneliness
- s-s-t 3: love = heaven
- Result?





## Body: sub-theme 2

What knowledge to pursue?

- s-s-t 1: hearts of men
- s-s-t 2: why the stars shine
- s-s-t 3: mathematics
- Result?



# Body: sub-theme 3

Pity for whom?

- s-s-t 1: children in famine (economical; *poverty*)
- s-s-t 2: tortured victims (political; *pain*)
- s-s-t 3: helpless old people (human; *loneliness*)
- Result?



# 'The Laws of Sociodynamics'

Theme: society is governed by three laws

- Sub-theme 1: (1<sup>st</sup> law) someone has to pay up
- Sub-theme 2: (2<sup>nd</sup> law) humans are motivated by own interests
- Sub-theme 3: (3<sup>rd</sup> law) positive reinforcement causes disaster



# Body: sub-theme 1

- s-s-t 1: Eastern Europe not isolated
- s-s-t 2: forms of free lunches
- s-s-t 3: what environmental regulation should do



## Body: sub-theme 2

- s-s-t 1: incentives subtle and difficult
- s-s-t 2: pluralism of incentives
- s-s-t 3: problems when incentives are mismatched



## Body: sub-theme 3

- s-s-t 1: why consequences are on such a large scale
- s-s-t 2: the hubris of bureaucracy
- s-s-t 3: the press (checks and balance) can help



# The Laws of Sociodynamics

Thesis/themes re-stated in summary:

Good societies follow these laws:

- 1<sup>st</sup>: facing true costs
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: providing proper incentives
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: being willing to expose errors and inefficiency
