Prof. Leung Mel-yee, programme director of the General Education (GE) Foundation Course, said, 'CUHK is the first university in Hong Kong to use core-text reading for general education. (Note: a 'core text' is the ultimate source text for a major philosophical or theological idea.) Our strong GE tradition had been largely aimed at broadening knowledge. By contrast, the new GE foundation courses move away from the science and arts divide, to focus on giving students a common intellectual experience involving common topics on cultures and traditions that have been influencing the world." Reading classical texts also serves to let students know what's important in university education, and what is demanded of them. 'We want them to read classical texts from different cultures, think about them, and tell each other and write about what they think. We want to take advantage of the '3+3+4' conversion to get students into the habit of discussing serious topics, and not expect everything to be dumbed down for ease of consumption."

In March this year the I-CARE Programme prepared a special gift for final-year students bidding farewell to the University. It was an unprecedented month-long cultural fiesta, featuring three sessions of public lectures on civility, and concluding with a grand-scale gala 'Blossoms of Life Floral Festival' held on 29 March by Lake Ad Excellentiam. 'Let us cherish the times when we can exchange ideas and ideas about life. Let us recite a poem, write a few lines of calligraphy, and take a photo to commemorate youthful times,' reads the event brochure.

How does a floral festival on campus relate to the theme of I-CARE, which is to enhance students' social awareness and participation? Prof. Chow Po-chung, convener of the Committee on the University Lecture on Civility, said the the programme's title 'I care' says it all. I-CARE does not set quantifiable outcomes as its goal. It's about emotional education which is lacking in university education. It provides a chance for students to cultivate and nurture the sensitivity that they desperately need, 'We care about our students, and our students care about society, people, the environment and the world. And to do that, you need to love nature. Immerse yourselves in the campus environment, love it and learn to appreciate it,' he said.

The committee members who organized the events believed that social concerns stem from aesthetic beliefs, which should not

be regarded merely as meant for personal enjoyment. A person must first have a romantic view of life before he or she can commit to social reform. Also, university graduates are more likely to contribute to society in unconventional ways if they have been encouraged by the ethos of their universities to break the mould.

Failure, Success, and Daring to Dream

In the first University Lecture on Civility, Prof. Lee Ou-fan unveiled to students the nobility of failures through his personal experience. His CV is undoubtedly very impressive, but who would have thought that the first half of life of this perfect scholar was pawed with adversities, twists and turns? Seeing disappointment as his best tutor, failure as his best friend, he gladly accepted everything and skilfully led a meaningful life.

More interested in the joys and sorrows of life during pivotal times in history than money-making, Hui's films have been critical though not always popular successes. To this day, she still finds herself preoccupied with raising funds for her next film. Despite the highs and lows, she remembers the challenges she has faced.

Prof. Pai Hsien-yung hosted the last lecture and gave an inspiring talk on the resilience of youth. He showed the audience a black-and-white photo of a group of university students who published Modern Literature and blazed a trail in Taiwan's literary circle. Seen seated in the lecture theatre were him and Prof. Lee Ou-fan, who, as young men, had dared to dream.

Prof. Chu Shun-chi Donna, director of the floral festival, said that the lectures were structured to first discuss failures, followed by a success and its challenges, and conclude with the dream to strive for the best.

Persistence is the main emphasis. All three lectures touched the audience and the lecture theatre was packed with staff, students and alumni. Speakers shared their stories and candid feelings, moving the young souls to reflect on life.

For Romário Galvão, Rio's secretary of sport, there's no real science behind running in Rio. "The city is defined by its marvellous landscape," he says. "From the mountains down to the beaches, when you run in Rio you are never short of a good view. There's no reason good view. There's no reason why anyone wouldn't want to jog here'. With an average annual temperature of 23C and 300km of designated running paths, Rio is indeed

an runner's ideal playground. Divided between the beaches and the lagoon, Rio's main routes are a matter of taste and timing: while early morning joggers capitalise on having the sand to themselves



to run barefoot along the shore to the sound of waves, for the post-work crowd, the lagoon offers a natural running circuit of 7.5km, although past 22.00, the flood-lit paim trees of the beach track (6.87km from Ipanema to Leblon and back) provide the safer option. While government support

includes converting one side of the beach road to a public promonade every Sunday and closing parts of the city for over 30 events a year, it is the independent running clubs that are providing the impetus "Running in Rio has become popular in a way it hasn't been since the 1980s," says Marcius Duarte, secretary of runners' association ATC RJ. "There are now more than 50 official running clubs with around 6,000 nembers and this number is growing every year."

As well as offering a sport, the team of experts educate runners on how to improve technique and train for big events. While Rio's 2012 Marathon (taking place in July, with sea views all the way) is limited to 19,000 participants, an increasing number of alternative races such as the Circuito Rio Antigo (which snakes through Rio's historic centre) are offering new ways to exercise through the city.

BEHIND THE SCENES

As John Speed's Theatre of the Empire of Great Britaine - the first atlas of the British Isles - approaches its 400th anniversary, we visit the University Library to take a look at a proof copy of one of the world's great cartographic treasures

VARIOUSLY DESCRIBED AS "charming". decorative" and "a supreme schievement. in British map-making, John Speed's Theatre of the Empire of Great Stituine is more than a map - it is a slice of Tudor and Jacobean life in miniature.

The atlas contains a single sheet for each county of England and Wales, plus a map of Scotland and each of the four Irish provinces, and paints a rich picture of the countryside at the turn of the 7th century. Rivers wriggle through the andscape, towns are shown as huddles of miniuture buildings, woods and parks are marked by tiny trees and - with contour lines yet to be invented - small scatterings of molehills denote higher ground. The countryside bursts with human

Inset into the corner of each county map is a plan of its county town and each spare inch of space is used to illustrate famous battles, local coats of arms, as wellas Roman and pre-historic stes. All that is missing are the roads because, bar certain bridges and a strench of the Romans' Warting Street, none are marked.

Anne Taylor, Head of the Map. Department at the University Library, often brings out Speed's Theater for visitors. But although the department holds several copies of the printed atlas, it is the hand-coloured set of proofs life: a ploughmen and his two-horse team produced between 1603 and 1611 that is

Bought by the University Library in 1968 after the government refused an export licence for the proofs to be sold abroad, and known as the Gardner copy after its previous owner. Arme describes it as "a nave and delightful item".

The Cambridgeshire sheet includes portraits of mixed academics, a pair of them holding the map's scale bar. 24 coats of arms of the University, colleges and local nobility, and the inset town plan is bordered by beautiful scroll work.

The Cambridge town plan, wrote the late Nigel Nicolson, author of The Counties of Britain: a Tudor Atlas, "gives a vivid miniature picture of the university and town compressed within an area which in those days extended no further than

Cardle Hill in the north and Peterhouse in the south!

Accompanying each map is a description of the county. Derived Samuely from William Carnelests Britonnia. a topographical and historical survey of Great British and heland, the text offers an affectionate portrait of the city and its university, but a rather less appealing description of the Cambridgeshire countryside.

"This province is not large, nor the air creatly to be liked, having the Fenns. so spread upon her North, that they infect the air far into the sect. The soil doth differ both in air and commodities: the Fenny surcharged with waters: the South is Champion, and yieldeth Com in abundance, with Meadowing costums upon both the sides of the River Came?

Important a map-maker was John Scient

and what was his cartographic legacy? Born in Farndon, Cheshire in 1551 or 1553. John Speed was a historian as well as a cartoorapher. Nicolson describes him as "an ambitious, energetic man, no-great scholar, more a compiler who drink together, both in his hispories and his maps, the researches and surveys. of others".

The county maps were the first consistent attempt to show territorial divisions, such as boundaries of hundreds. but it was Speed's town plans that were a major innovation and probably

his greatest contribution to Sritish cartography. Together, they formed the first printed collection of town plans of the British likes and, for at least 50 of the 73 included in the Theatre, it was the first time these towns had been mapped.

flest described as "map views", the town plans are a combination of ground plan with bird's eye perspective."The vews set out deliberately to chann," Nicolson wrote. "They represent the towns and cities as havens of peace and industry, near and speckless."

Although we know little about Speed's life, some detective work by Emmanus College's Development Director and Fellow Librarian Dr Sarah Bendall - who discovered drafts of Speed's town plans at Merton College, Oxford - uncovered clues about how he worked during the arrayers of 1606 to 1606.

According to Dr Bendall: "Initials on four of the sheets suggest that Speed was helped by his son John in 1606. The draft maps also show that his surveying technique was probably a compass traverse using a plane table, and that he worked quickly - he was in Ely on 5 July 1607, Huntingdon on 7 July and Peterborough a day later."

From 1607 to 1611 the gifted Flemish. engrayer and map-maker Jodocus. Handius Sr produced the copper plates from which the Theatre was printed. plates that passed between publishers for the next 150 years.

When published - as an accompaniment to Speed's Historie of Great Britisine - in 163 1-12 the Theotor was an immediate success: the first print non of around 500 copies must have solid quickly because many editions followed and, by the time of the 1627 edition, the actias cost 40 shiftings

Both the price and the absence of roads suggest the Theate would have been bought by local landowners as a status symbol and tool of administrative control. Nicolson imagined too that they might have served the same purpose as today's coffee table volumes.

The Theatre was a supreme achievement in British cartography It made john Speed into one of the most famous of all our map-makers and became the bisoprint for folio atlases. until the mid-10th century.

team have two potential applications. They can be used to make a 'mixing-entropy battery' that takes advantage of the salinity difference between seawater and freshwater to produce electricity. They can also be used to de-salinate seawater to make drinkable water by controlling the HR with light so that chloride ions of seawater are absorbed by bacteria. Their ideas, if realized, can help address two pressing environmental issues: water and energy.

The team comprises four CUHK IGEM 2011 professors (Prof. Chan Ting-fung

Philos, Prof Chan King-ming, Prof. Kong Siu-kai and Prof. Yip Yuk-lap Kevin), three student instructors, and 24 undergraduate students, including 19 life sciences students, four engineering students and one chemistry student. These young researchers believe in Einstein's words: 'Imagination is more important than knowledge." Their imagination has opened up undreamedof possibilities for HR. Their creative project won a gold medal at the iGEM (International Genetic Engineered Machine) Asia Regional Jamboree in October 2011. They also won the Best BioBrick Measurement Approach and the Best New BioBrick Part (Natural) awards.

Gordon Chan, a biochemistry student, said, 'iGEM offers us a rare opportunity to use state-of-theart technological instruments and polish skills that are beyond the boundaries of the formal curriculum, including experimental techniques, writing skills, leadership skills, social skills, statistical analysis and presentation skills. The heavy workload also trained up my perseverance.

The students' work was greatly acclaimed by the panel of judges. One of the judges, Prof. Mukund Thattai of the National Centre for Biological Sciences, India, who presented the team with the Best BioBrick Measurement Approach award, commented that the team had done extensive characterizations to the BioBrick which is well ready for use by the research community. Another panel judge, Prof. Qi Ouyang of Peking University, who presented the team with the Best New BioBrick Part (Natural) award, commended the team's creativity in making use of an ion transporter found in bacteria to generate electricity.

Color Harmonies

Basic techniques for combining colors

Below are shown the basic color chords based on the color wheel.




Complementary

Colors that are opposite each other on the color wheel are considered to be complementary colors (example: red and green).

The high contrast of complementary colors creates a vibrant look especially when used at full saturation. This color scheme must be managed well so it is not jarring.

Complementary colors are tricky to use in large doses, but work well when you want something to stand out.

Complementary colors are really bad for text.


Analogous

Analogous color schemes use colors that are next to each other on the color wheel. They usually match well and create serene and comfortable designs.

Analogous color schemes are often found in nature and are harmonious and pleasing to the eye.

Make sure you have enough contrast when choosing an analogous color scheme.

Choose one color to dominate, a second to support. The third color is used (along with black, white or gray) as an accent.




Triad

A triadic color scheme uses colors that are evenly spaced around the color wheel.

Triadic color harmonies tend to be quite vibrant, even if you use pale or unsaturated versions of your hues.

To use a triadic harmony successfully, the colors should be carefully balanced - let one color dominate and use the two others for accent.






Split-Complementary

The split-complementary color scheme is a variation of the complementary color scheme. In addition to the base color, it uses the two colors adjacent to its complement.

This color scheme has the same strong visual contrast as the complementary color scheme, but has less tension.

The split-complimentary color scheme is often a good choice for beginners, because it is difficult to mess up.



Next Stop, Community

In recent years, the University Grants Committee (UGC) has encouraged Hong Kong's tertiary institutions to regard the boosting of capacity in knowledge transfer (KT) as their third mission, in addition to teaching and research. In order to achieve synergy and offer streamlined support and services for its Faculties and the industries, the University established the Knowledge Transfer Office by merging the Knowledge Transfer Unit and the Technology Licensing Office in March 2011. The three core functions of the office are technology development, communitybased projects, and contracts and legal affairs.

The UGC has provided Recurrent Funding for Knowledge Transfer for the triennium 2009-2012. The year under review was the second year of this triennium, in which the University reaped a rich harvest.

On the technology front, two new funding schemes. namely, 'Patent Application Fund' and 'Technology and Business Development Fund', have been launched to further support technology protection, development and commercialization. In 2010-11, a total of 148 patents were filed and 68 of them were granted. There has also 合約研究及顧問服務方面的收入也創出新 been a remarkable growth in the income generated from contract research and consultancy.

> Since 2010, the KT Fund has been utilized to support not only projects of the Faculties, but also university-wide initiatives that build and enhance infrastructure to facilitate KT. There is inter-departmental collaboration to contribute to the overall capacity of the University. Examples of such funded projects are Databases for Industrial Contacts (led by the Centre for Innovation and Technology), Global Entrepreneurship Week Hong Kong and CUHK Alumni Entrepreneur Network (led by the Centre for Entrepreneurship).

A total of 25 projects with high social impact were supported by the Knowledge Transfer Project Fund. For this new round of projects in 2010-11, 'new initiatives'

was one of the criteria for funding. A typical example is Learning from Neighbourhood Tourism in Sheung Wan, Hong Kong, which is an interdisciplinary collaboration between the Department of Anthropology and the
