





Professor of Nursing Lectures


on Recovery from Stroke

In her professorial inaugural lecture entitled 'Recovery from Stroke: the Evidence for Nursing', Prof. Ann Mackenzie explored the effect of rehabilitation on stroke patients and how it may be improved by the therapeutic interventions of nurses.

Evidence drawn from the ongoing research in the Department of Nursing indicates that self-esteem is an important factor in recovery and that psychological variables account



Prof. Mackenzie, currently chair of the Department of Nursing, was appointed professor of nursing (clinical nursing) on 1st June 1995. Her inaugural lecture was delivered on 31st October at the Prince of Wales Hospital.



The first of the lecture series 'Unexplored Treasure: Information Technology Education', launched by the Faculty of Education and the Hong Kong Institute of Educational Research, took place on 1st November.

The theme of the first lecture was information technology and language education. It explored the integration of information technology in the teaching of Chinese and English

reading and writing, and reviewed the difficulties and obstacles in the implemention of information technology education in secondary schools and universities. The lecture was conducted by Prof. Chen Hsuan Chih of the Department of Psychology, Ms. Jose Lai Chan Sau-hing of the English Language Teaching Unit, Prof. Wong Po-choi of the Department of Information Engineering, and Mr. Yip Chee-tim of Pui Ching Middle School.

Relaunch of Fight for Sight Hotline

The University's Department of Ophthalmology and Visual Sciences has relaunched its 24-hour hotline in October following a successful three-month pilot scheme ending in August.

Results of the scheme showed that the hotline was in high demand and was a much valued source of information on eye care, eye diseases, eye clinics, and the Fight for Sight Foundation's educational materials.

The Fight for Sight Foundation was established in August 1996 to help those in the territory with eye disease and other vision impairments. The hotline 187-8826 is its first step in providing eye care facilities to the public.

Faculty of Social Science Compiles the First Dean's List

Eighty-six students in the Faculty of Social Science have been selected for inclusion on the Dean's List for 1996-97. All of them are academically outstanding, and have obtained a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.60 or above for the year. They represent 4.67 per cent of the total enrolment in the faculty.

The first of its kind in the University, the Dean's List for the Faculty of Social Science was compiled in response to a proposal by the Publicity Committee of the Faculty

Board, who believes that the honour of being included on the list may be helpful to students in competing for scholarships and employment, and in application for further studies. The proposal was endorsed by the Faculty Board last June.

Only students with year GPA 3.60 or above will be granted the honour, which is higher than the 3.50 cut-off for first class honours. The University has already been requested to consider including the honour in the students' academic transcripts.

Medical Staff Appointed Sims Black Professor by Royal College

Prof. Allan Chang Mang-zing, subdean (clinical) of the Faculty of Medicine and chairman of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, was appointed Sims Black Professor for 1997 by the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists. Prof. Chang is the first Chinese academic to have received this prestigious appointment.

The Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists was founded in

1929 for the promotion of the science and practice of obstetrics and gynaecology. Each year, the college appoints an outstanding obstetrician or gynaecologist from England or the British Commonwealth as Sims Black Professor. The person thus honoured is

The Royal College has been instrumental to the establishment of and standard-setting for the Hong Kong College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists. Prof. Chang was president of the Hong Kong College from 1992 to 1994.

More Networking & Publicity Required

New director of the Environmental Science Programme, Prof. Jimmy Yu believes that the programme needs greater exposure to the public. To this end, he and other staff members of the programme are organizing a consultative committee which draws its members from senior officials of the government's Environmental Protection Department, managers of consultancy firms, and academics from the world over who are experienced in research and teaching related to the environment. 'We hope the committee will help us build a network to facilitate academic exchange and to open up more career opportunities for our graduates,' he said. The committee will have its first meeting, Prof. Yu hopes, at the end of the year.

A Multidisciplinary Programme

Established in 1994-95, the programme has been fairing well in its three years of existence. It takes in approximately 30 students each year, and so far, most graduates have found jobs related directly or indirectly to environmental science, while others have taken up postgraduate studies. Part of the credit goes to the programme's solid curriculum and dedicated teachers.

Its curriculum, which includes studies in environmental chemistry, environmental biology, conservation, biochemical toxicology, environmental impact assessment, is taught mainly by six teachers from the

Pros and Cons of Being Young

Virtually all academic units and departments of Hong Kong's tertiary institutions are faced with two problems: space and resources. Being a young and expanding programme, the Environmental Science Programme probably feels the effect of these universal problems even more acutely. 'Research laboratory space is extremely tight at present,' said Prof. Yu, 'and it will worsen as we expand the postgraduate programme.' To build up its technological capacity, the programme has procured some advanced equipment over the past few years. Additional resources, however, are crucial to the maintenance of the equipment.

As the programme is organized by the departments of biochemistry, biology, and chemistry, its funds are also allocated via the three departments, which means it enjoys little financial independence.

Being young, however, has its merits. Prof. Yu pointed out, 'We're a young programme taught by relatively young staff members. We are openminded and highly adaptable, hence there should be few in the way of obstacles when changes need to be introduced. And because we're young and few in number, we get along very smoothly.'

New Director Ready to Take Up the Challenge

Prof. Yu joined the University in August 1995. He first became involved with the Environmental Science Programme in 1993 when he spent his sabbatical at the University. He 'feels lucky' to belong to both the Department of Chemistry and the Environmental Science Programme as he has received 'strong support in pursuing excellence in research and teaching from both.' Prof. Yu's research interests lie in environmental monitoring and waste treatment, as well as treatment technology. Although the duties of programme director will leave him less time for research, Prof. Yu is prepared for it. 'I knew when I agreed to take on the job what it entails. My research is on the right track, so I can delegate part of my work to my research assistants. I don't know yet whether I'll find the work load heavy. I just hope it will turn out to be a rewarding experience in the end,' concluded Prof. Yu placidly.

Hui Sai-chuen 許世全


Assistant Professor in the Department of Sports Science and Physical Education from 1st September 1997 (Ext. 6081); previously assistant physical education officer at Lingnan College.



觸覺訊息如何傳遞? 追查麥高爾氏細胞的功能

我們總是相信自 己的眼睛和耳朵,常 常忽略了觸覺。然 而,人類和其他哺乳 類動物出生時都只是 依靠觸覺來尋找母 乳,一些夜行動物和 失明人士更要靠觸覺 來辨認四周環境。事 實上,我們的觸覺極 爲靈敏——手指尖可 以感受到只有數毫克 的輕壓。

究竟皮膚是怎樣 把受到的壓力傳達至 中樞神經呢?原來表 皮之下有各種對壓力 敏感的受體,它們受 到刺激便會產生電脈 衝(神經細胞均以電脈 衝傳遞訊息),這些訊 息經過神經纖維傳到 我們的中樞神經。

表皮之下,還存 著一組又一組的麥高

爾氏細胞,與神經纖維組成一個系統,稱麥高爾氏細 胞受體。由於這類受體的結構和特性都類似神經系統 內傳遞化學訊息的「突觸」構造(指一個神經元的軸突 接觸並影響另一個神經元的樹突或胞體的部位),科 學家便推想麥高爾氏細胞可能擔當轉化及傳遞訊息的 任務。

要證明並不容易,因爲麥高爾氏細胞位於堅硬的 表皮和由膠原纖維組成的眞皮之間,難以直接觀察。 即使微電極(插入神經細胞或肌肉組織,用以檢測其 電脈衝的超小型電極)也無法接近和量度它們的活 動。所以,麥高爾氏細胞的功能向來廣受爭議。

聲音傳遞的啓示

麥高爾氏細胞的結構其實類似人體內耳的毛聽細 胞;毛聽細胞專責把聲音頻率轉化成電脈衝生物訊 息,運作時會打開一條通道,讓鈣離子進入細胞內, 擔當信差。本校生理學系鮑曼教授(已離職)及容永豪 教授遂構思研究麥高爾氏細胞的鈣離子含量

他們與研究生陳絢素及Solomon Senok組成研究 小組,於九二年開展「哺乳類感覺受體麥高爾氏細胞 的分子機制」研究計劃,並獲研究資助局撥款七十二 萬七千元支持。該研究於九五年完成,初步肯定了麥 高爾氏細胞的功能,更於去年底獲研究資助局評爲 「卓越」的研究項目。

突破技術限制 成功分離細胞試驗

容教授說:「研究的 最大困難,是先要從哺乳 類動物分離活生生而功能 正常的麥高爾氏細胞受體 作實驗,過去未曾有人做 到。」研究小組從依靠觸 覺的老鼠著手, 牠們的觸 鬚也有很多麥高爾氏細胞 受體,而且相對來說較易 分離。陳絢素在缺乏文獻 和研究資料的情況下,反 復嘗試,藉切割顯微鏡的 幫助,最終成功把完整且 活生的麥高爾氏細胞受體 和鄰近的組織分隔;被分 隔的麥高爾氏細胞給一層 亮薄的膜包圍(圖一),連 附神經纖維,可供進行實 驗。容教授相信此項技術 突破是研究計劃獲評爲 「卓越」的主要原因之一。

鈣離子含量增加

研究小組再採用螢光測定法來檢測鈣離子的含 量。他們先將一種與鈣離子結合後即產生光譜變化的 化學品注入分離出來的麥高爾氏細胞,然後輕按細 胞,再比對細胞在受刺激前後的光譜變化,從而得知 鈣離子含量的差別。

顯示具傳遞功能


另一方面,Solomon Senok負責量度整組受體的 電脈衝,以確定受體是否在接受訊息。研究小組又把 研究樣本送到德國漢堡大學,由專家以電子顯微技 術,檢測麥高爾氏細胞受體的結構是否完整。

初步研究的結果顯示經壓力刺激後,麥高爾氏細 胞的鈣離子含量增加,受體亦有反應(圖二)。換句話 說,這些細胞確是擔負著傳遞訊息的任務。

研究尚待改進

雖然研究計劃是走對了路,取得突破,但研究人 員每次實驗所得之鈣離子含量參差。容敎授解釋,這 是因爲細胞太小,實難每次施以相同力度的刺激,而 且鈣的分布是集中於細胞內某處,難以精確把握。爲 使研究更準確,兩位教授再以化學劑腺嘌吟核苷三磷 酸(ATP)及高濃度的氯化鉀(KCI)替代機械刺激,以 確保麥高爾氏細胞每次均受到相同刺激。實驗顯示細 胞反應與接受壓力刺激時一致(圖二)。

由於神經細胞都是以細胞膜的電壓變化來傳遞訊 息,如果能夠量度麥高爾氏細胞的細胞膜電流,便可 更有力地證明它們的功能。鮑曼教授及容教授於九五 年再取得研究資助局五十三萬一千元的撥款,開展更 深入的「麥高爾氏細胞受體的機械電轉導電流」研究計 劃。□ (資料整理:陳偉珠 蔡世彬)

三十周年專題演講



關於《爾雅》一書的若干考察

中國古代哲學、語言學著名學者 劉殿爵教授上月十八日以「關於〈爾 雅》一書的若干考察」爲題,推論《爾 雅》一書之編纂方法,見解獨到,不 囿於傳統舊說而自出機杼。傳統學說 均以爲《爾雅》乃一部古代訓詁詞典, 然而劉教授近十年不斷搜集到例證, 證明〈爾雅〉乃秦漢間學者選取習用典

籍,尤其《詩經》、〈尚書〉中某些詞語用例及前人之解釋,重新編排成書,所收 解釋並不絕對正確,有些更屬望文生訓,因此不能泛用於解釋其他典籍用例。

劉教授長期從事先秦兩漢典籍研究,在海內外享有盛名。劉教授治學嚴 謹,造詣精深,以精確的語言翻譯古代典籍,其中(論語)、(孟子)、(老子)三 書英譯,已成海外研習中國哲學必讀之書。

冼爲堅當代中國文化講座

著名中國作家張承志和余華上月廿四日主持今年的「冼爲堅當代中國文化講 座」,題目分別爲「牧人的筆記」和「我能否相信自己」,展現他們對近代文化研究 的新觀點。

張承志是當代中國的著名作家,早期作品如《綠夜》、《黑駿馬》、《北方的 河》、《胡涂亂抹》以其獨特的浪漫氣質和理想主義廣受注意。這些短篇作品及其 長篇小說(金牧場)和(金草地),以知青生活爲題材,創造了一個特殊的文學世 界。一九九零年以來,他發表了大量散文和以回族歷史爲背景的長篇《心靈 史》,成爲當代大陸文化論爭中備受矚目的人物。改編自其同名作品的電影《黑 駿馬)曾在德國柏林電影節獲獎。

余華也是當代中國著名 作家,一九八七年發表《十八 歲出門遠行〉後,迅即引起讀 者的注意。他的短篇小說《現 實一種》、《一九八六年》、 《四月三日事件》、《世事如 煙》和《難逃劫數》,均以靈活



的敘事手法創造了一個充滿暴力與瘋狂的世界。踏入九十年代,他又創作了《呼 喊與細雨〉、〈活着〉和〈許三官買血記〉等長篇小說,廣受好評。由其作品改編的 電影(活著)曾在法國康城電影節獲獎。 中國文化研究所 1967-97

文字起於鳥迹説與越文化圈

著名漢學家饒宗頤教授鑽研古代 史地數十年,博涉甲骨簡帛多方面出土 新資料,屢有創見,極著時譽。

他於上月卅一日以「文字起於鳥 迹說與越文化圈」爲題,從宏觀角度察 看文字起源的問題,提出嶄新的看法。

他在講座上表示,從吐魯番文書

印證古代造字出於鳥迹之說,有其充分考古學的論據。同時古代越族至春秋時 代被認爲四分天下有其一,而越族分布地區都有大量陶文出土,可能延伸及於 域外,形成一極大文化圈。

中風後的復元
