

China's Development Elucidated at **CUHK-UN Seminar**

cademics, government officials, policy advisers, A representatives of the business community and the consular corps from Hong Kong and Macau attended the seminar, 'China Human Development Report: Development with Equity', jointly organized by CUHK and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) on 3rd April. The seminar was moderated by Prof. Lawrence J. Lau, vice-chancellor of the University.

The seminar focused on the China Human Development Report 2005 which was commissioned by UNDP China, coordinated by the China Development Research Foundation, and written by 13 eminent scholars and experts including one from CUHK. Released last December, it illuminated the human development status in China by analyzing the country's income and wealth distribution, employment opportunities, social security, and public expenditure.

The background, contents, recommendations, and global significance of the report were introduced by Mr. Lu Mai, secretarygeneral, China Development Research Foundation and senior research fellow, Development Research Centre of the State Council of the PRC; Mr. Renaud Meyer, deputy resident representative of UNDP China; and Dr. Shahrbanou Tadjbakhsh, director of the Centre for Peace and Human Security, Sciences Po Paris.

Wei Lun Lecture by **Eminent Translation Scholar**

Prof. Mona Baker, professor of translation studies at the University of Manchester, delivered a lecture entitled 'Framing Narratives in Translation' in her capacity as Wei Lun Visiting Scholar to the University, on 24th March in the Mong Man Wai Building.

The lecture drew on the eminently concrete notion of narrative and the notion of framing, the latter as developed particularly in the literature on social movements, to explore various ways in which translators and interpreters accentuate, undermine or modify contested aspects of the narrative(s) encoded in the source text or utterance.

Prof. Baker is a world renowned translation scholar. She is the vice-president of the International Association of Translation and Intercultural Studies. She was Projects Manager at Cobuild where she was responsible for designing a new range of bilingual dictionaries based on the translation of existing Cobuild dictionaries.

Prof. Baker has also made extraordinary contributions to the development of translator training. Her book, In Other Words: A Coursebook on Translation, has been reprinted 12 times since 1992 and is widely used as a standard textbook in many parts of the world. She was also the editor of Translation and Conflict: A Narrative Account, and The Routledge Encyclopaedia of Translation Studies.

Weiyuan Lake : Perfect Mix of Form and Function

he Chinese University has the largest campus in Hong Kong at 134 hectares. Satellite images indicate that approximately 77% of this area is covered by vegetation. Protecting such a large area is not easy watering it alone is enough of a challenge.

As using fresh water would go against both economic and greening principles, the University had always used nullah water to irrigate its campus. However acquiring water from outside entails high maintenance costs for the supply system as well as an unsteady or inadequate water supply. The University soon found an ideal solution within its walls — in its very own Weiyuan Lake, Chung Chi College

The University began by clearing away the mud and silt in the lake to increase its water storage level; it also improved its pumping system. In addition, an automatic watergate was installed in the lake in 2003 to manage the water level. At present, the lake supplies a decent 700,000 litres of water to the University per day, which is not only sufficient for watering the whole campus, but leaves enough for cooling its air-conditioning systems and flushing.

This is a story of how a scenic lake has been turned into a sustainable source of life.

CUHK Study Finds Girls Enjoy Reading More Than Boys

ccording to a recent study conducted by CUHK 1 researchers, the reason girls outscore boys in reading all around the world is that girls enjoy reading more.

Prof. Chiu Ming-ming of the Department of Educational Psychology and Prof. Catherine McBride of the Department of Psychology conducted a large-scale international study of how gender and reading enjoyment affect reading literacy. The study was based on the PISA (Program for International Student Assessment) data released by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development. The data included the reading test scores and questionnaire responses of close to 200,000 fifteen-year olds in 43 countries and regions, including Hong Kong.

In all regions, girls outscored boys by 9% in reading on average. Moreover, adolescent boys were more likely to be illiterate (14%) compared to girls of the same age (8%). Interestingly, Hong Kong had the fourth smallest gender gap with only 4% illiterate boys and 1.4% illiterate girls. Many of the gender differences noted could be explained by environmental and social influences on literacy, such as schoolmates' family socio-economic status, reading enjoyment, country income, family socio-economic status, and number of books at home.

Notably, girls tended to report enjoyment in reading more than boys; and Hong Kong students had the third highest reading enjoyment rating. After accounting for the above factors, it was found that gender differences explained only about 1% of the differences in reading literacy and the researchers believe this 1% might be biological.

The study's results suggest that adolescents whose families value reading and who enjoy reading will tend to read better. These findings show the value of home literacy for adolescents. As reading for enjoyment is linked to reading competence, the researchers recommend allowing adolescents to select their own reading materials.



East-wing galleries, Art Museum

An opening ceremony hosted by Prof. Liu Pak Wai, pro-vice-chancellor, will be held at 4.30 p.m. on 21st April 2006. Mr. Zang Ling, director of Yu Garden Management Office, will officiate at the ceremony.

The Yu Garden, located in the Southeast of Shanghai City, is a classical Chinese garden of the South. The construction of the garden took place in the Jiajing reign (1522-1566) of the Ming dynasty. Since then it had become the birthplace of the Shanghai Painting School and a meeting place for painters, calligraphers and epigraphists. The Management Office of the Yu Garden has acquired more than a thousand pieces of painting and calligraphy by renowned Qing to modern Shanghai artists over years. Fifty pieces have been selected for this exhibition, including 30 paintings and 20 works of calligraphy. Among the distinctive paintings are landscapes by Feng Chaoran, Huang Shanshou, Wu Qinmu, Pu Hua and Wu Qingyun; bird-and-flower paintings by Ren Yi, Zhao Yunhe, Wang Yachen and Zhang Dazhuan; and portraits by Feng Zikai, Qian Huian and Wang Zhen. In calligraphy, equally significant works are shown, including seal script by Huang Binhong and Tong Danian; clerical script by Zeng Xi and Ma Gongyu; regular script by Pan Boying; running script by He Shaoji, Shen Yunmo and Wu Hufan; and also cursive script by Xie Zhiliu. The exhibition is organized with an aim to feature eminent Shanghai artists and their unique styles of the late Qing to modern periods so as to enhance cultural exchange between Hong Kong and Shanghai.

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女孩喜歡看書 閱讀能力較強

校的研究指出,女孩一般較男孩更享受閱讀,因而閱讀能力較強;而家長 和教師若多加鼓勵,有助提高孩子的閱讀能力。

研究由教育心理學系趙明明教授和心理學系Catherine McBride教授合作, 利用經濟合作及發展組織的「學生能力國際評估計劃」(PISA)的原始數據進 行,是首個關於性別及閱讀興趣如何影響閱讀能力的國際大型研究計劃

研究結果顯示,女孩無論在整體閱讀能力或基本認字表現均比男孩為佳。 在四十三個國家和地區中,女孩平均較男孩得分多百分之九。在青少年中,男 孩和女孩的文盲比率分別為百分之十四和百分之八。香港文盲的性別差異不 大,男孩和女孩的比率為百分之四和百分之一點四。而環境和社會因素,是導 致性別差異的主因。總體來說,下列因素可促進青少年的閱讀成績:

- (一) 同學的家庭社會經濟背景提升一成,有助提升其閱讀成績百分
- (二) 個人閱讀興趣提升一成,有助提升其閱讀成績百分之二。
- (三) 國家收入提升一成,有助提升其閱讀成績百分之二。
- (四) 本身的家庭社會經濟背景提升一成,有助提升其閱讀成績百分
- (五) 家中藏書增添一成,有助提升其閱讀成績百分之一。

研究又顯示,香港學生在閱讀能力方面並無多大性別差異,在四十三個國 家和地區中的閱讀與趣指數排名第三。若家庭重視閱讀(由家中藏書量反映), 而青少年自己亦享受閱讀的話,則其閱讀能力會較佳。

研究人員指出,家庭閱讀能力對青少年有重大影響,但這方面的研究仍 不足。由於閱讀興趣和閱讀能力互為影響,成年人應容許青少年選擇自己喜 好的讀物,就算青少年對正統書籍不感興趣,亦可享受閱讀漫畫、雜誌或網 誌的樂趣。

善用天然水源

面積達一百三十四公頃 據衛星圖片顯示,約七成七的面 積有植物覆蓋。要護理這大片綠 色土地殊不簡單,光是灌溉已大 費周章。如果使用自來水的話, 不但費用昂貴,也不環保。

是以,大學一直都利用天然 山水灌溉花草,但從校外取水, 供應系統的保養費用巨大,且供 水量亦可能不穩定或不足。為了 徹底解決問題,校方清理了崇基 未圓湖的淤泥,增加儲水量,並 改善水泵系統,更於二零零三年 在未圓湖安裝自動水閘,控制湖 水。現在,大學每天從未圓湖抽 水達七十萬公升,足夠灌溉整個 校園,更可作冷卻空調系統和沖 廁之用,既環保又節省水費。

長期痛症可引致抑鬱

港健康情緒中心的研究顯示,患長期痛症的人士有較大機會同時患上抑鬱症,但 日 病患者卻甚少求助。

研究委託香港亞太研 究所進行,於三月七日至 四月四日以全港隨機抽樣 電話訪問了五千多名十八 至六十五歲的市民。

結果發現, 逾半受訪 者在過去一年至少患上以 下其中一種長期痛症:頸 背痛、頭痛和風濕關節 炎。以年齡和就業組別計 算,女性、長者、失業者 及退休人士患上長期痛症



的比率較高。而長期痛症患者同時患上抑鬱症的風險,是沒有長期痛症者的五點六 倍;長期痛症患者有自殺傾向的風險,亦是沒有者的二點四倍。同時患上三種痛症 者,患上抑鬱症的風險是沒有者的十三點九倍。但只有少數患者會尋求專業治療,顯 示公眾對抑鬱症的了解頗為貧乏。

中心主管李誠教授表示,若抑鬱症未能及早診治,可能引發更嚴重的痛楚。病人 一旦陷入長期痛症和抑鬱症的惡性循環之中,便會有更高的自殺率。



中大與聯合國合辦會議 探討中國發展概況

校與聯合國開發計劃署於四月三日合 辦「中國人類發展報告:追求公平的人 類發展」研討會,推動各界對中國發展的關 注及討論。

研討會在中大中區教學中心舉行,由劉 遵義校長主持,主要討論《中國人類發展報 告2005》。這份報告由聯合國開發計劃署駐 華代表處委託中國發展研究基金會協調十 三位專家,包括中大的學者撰寫。報告於 去年十二月公布,以「追求公平的人類發 展」為主題,透過分析中國的收入及財產分 配、就業機會、社會保障、公共支出等情 況,反映中國的人類發展現狀。

中國發展研究基金會秘書長暨國務院發展研究中心研究員盧邁先生、聯合國開發計劃署駐華副代表Renaud Meyer先生,以及

巴黎政治科學院和平與人類安全中心主任 Shahrbanou Tadjbakhsh博士,在會上介紹了 該報告的背景、內容和政策建議,並分析 對全球的意義。他們和與會的學者專家、 政府官員、政策分析員、商界領袖及各國 領事等,一起討論中國的發展問題與對 策,以及對香港的影響。

該報告指出中國自改革開放以來,由經濟奇蹟所帶動的社會和人類發展,取得了巨大進步。研究人員利用預期壽命、教育程度和經濟發展水平,計算「人類發展指數」。中國於二零零三年的指數是0.755,在全球一百七十七個國家和地區中排名八十五,列入中度人類發展國家;排名較一九九零年時上升了百分之二十,是歷來最大的增幅,主要原因是中國的收入增長強勁。


偉倫講座:論翻譯與敘事框架
